## Yale-New Haven Teachers Institute Seminar description for 2023 Juno Jill Richards, Associate Professor of English

## Writing Queer and Trans Lives

This seminar offers a wide-ranging introduction to LGBTQ life writing, here broadly construed as genres of queer and trans self-fashioning, including autobiography, graphic novels, zines, essays, diaries, and autobiographical fiction. The seminar will approach these works alongside background reading in the history of sexuality, moving from the pre-Stonewall era to the present day. A component of the seminar will include creative approaches to narrative non-fiction, or ways of telling the story of a life, through zine making, journaling, podcasting, documentary, and collaborative writing projects.
